### List of Suitable species for property owners adjacent to the river and wetland areas

While the planting of indigenous plant species and lawns is encouraged, homeowners may plant any plant with the exception of the following :

- any plant listed as an invasive alien plant in Table 3 of the Conservation of Agricultural Resources Act, 1983, (Act No. 43 of 1983); and
- any cactuses, conifers or palms.
