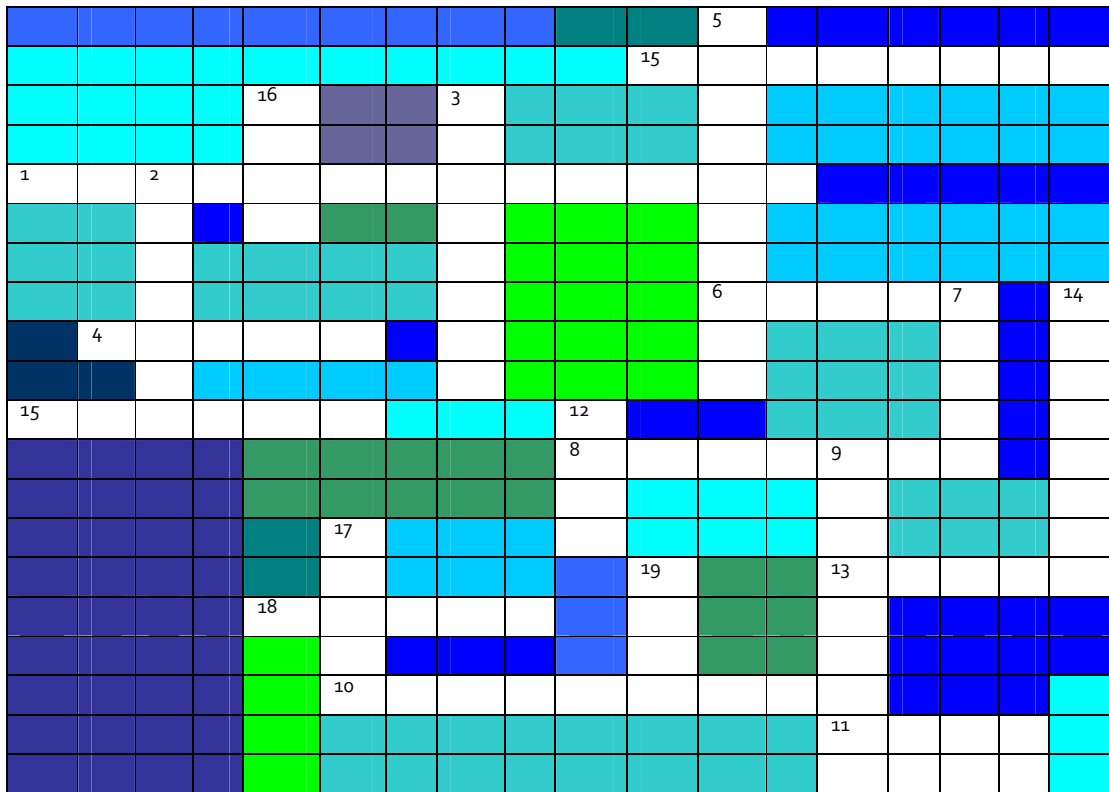


**ACTIVITY 1: CROSS WORD ACTIVITY RELATING TO WATER:**
