

Operating Procedure for Application of Golf Course Herbicides and Pesticides		
A	Monitoring	Responsible
	1 All playing areas are regularly monitored for pests and disease. Application of chemical remedies will be effected only when necessary, whilst seeking to use the minimum quantity of appropriate pesticide/fungicide/remedy in order to achieve the required result.	GC
	2 To minimise the agricultural remedies required, pesticides/fungicides/remedies are used in a preventative manner to restrict the building up of resistance from diseases.	Info
B	Application of agricultural remedies - General	Responsible
	1 Spraying of playing areas will under normal conditions take place as and when necessary, and the application will be carried out in fair weather conditions.	Info
	2 Application of agricultural remedies will be done in accordance with the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, the Fertilizer, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act (Act36 of 1947).	Info
	3 Only products that have been approved and registered for use in South Africa are used. The listing of approved products is reviewed reguarly to ensure ongoing compliance.	Info
	4 The application, dosage and safety precautions as set out on the "Product labels" and "Material Safety Data Sheets" (MSDS) of products are followed. All MSDS's of the products being used are available at the offices of the HOA and the Golf Course Supintendant.	Info
	5 All spraying will be done in compliance to the relevant legislation.	Info
	6 The Estate ECO will, in conjunction with Southern Turf Management (STM)and the Pest Control Officer (PCO), monitor the prevalent weather conditions and if the conditions are unfavourable for spraying, the spraying will be terminated forthwith.	ECO
	7 The storage of all chemicals will be done in accordance with the Health and Safety Act 85 of 1993	GC
C	Application of chemical remedies - Golf Playing Surfaces	Responsible
	1 Notification of application of chemical remedies will be sent to the Estate Manager and the Residents at least 48 hours prior to the spraying action. Such notification will be sufficient and valid for 2 consecutive days of spraying.	GC
	2 The products being used, the areas the that will be sprayed, the MSDS forms of the products being used as well as all other information required by Act 36 will be communicated to the Estate Manager and Residents prior to the planned spraying.	GC
	3 All spraying will be done with compliance to the relevant legislation and , and the ECO will be present to monitor the spraying over the period.	Info
D	Communication & Co-ordination	Responsible
	1 All requests or queries regarding spraying from Home Owners must be directed to the Estate Manager (Patrick Holden)who will contact the Golf Club Manager. The HOA/Estate Manager will co-ordinate any and all information flowing to and from De Zalze Residents, including specificaly the information/ notices as per C1.	HOA
	2 Spraying will be done in windless conditions and at times that have the least interference to golfers on the fairways and greens.	Info
	3 STM personnel working on the playing areas will always have right of way during application	Info
	4 Signage will be prominently displayed at the Entrances to the Estate within the notice period.	Info
